



What to Expect of Your Visit

Your appointment can range from 15 to 30 minutes long depending on the type of visit

Physical Exam

Scheduled once a year to assess overall health

Follow-up Visit

To follow-up on a particular health need you might have

Nurse Visit

A visit typically with the nurse only for recommended follow-up and/or education

Insurance Enrollment

Bring to appointment (if possible):

- Social Security Number & Date of birth
- Current Wages (4 paystubs), Taxes or Other Income
- US passport, Resident Card, or other legal paperwork
- Email Address
- Employer Insurance Information (If enrolled or offered)
- Healthsource RI Account number

Sick Visit

Focused specifically on the problem you are having the day of your scheduled appointment

Pedi Visit: Only a legal guardian or adult authorized to consent for the minor can bring the child to the visit

OBGYN Visit

Obstetric/gynecological visit. Bring any important documents & medications if applicable

New Patient Visit

You might be given a registration appt. before your new patient visit. Please arrive early to collect all necessary documentation before your first visit at PCHC.

Reproductive Health Counselor

Focused on contraceptive care

Please arrive to your appointment 15 minutes early!
Please call the clinic if you need to reschedule.



What to Bring to Your Appointment

Insurance Card (if applicable)



Identification e.g., Driver's License



Medical Record & Immunization Record



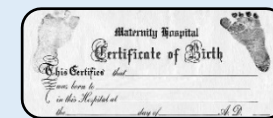
All medications (e.g., prescriptions, over the counter medications, herbal remedies, etc.)
